1 Peter 2:11-12

Read 1 Peter 2:11-12 as a family and discuss the following questions. Feel free to skip or adjust questions to accommodate your child's age and stage of development. Be sensitive to how the Holy Spirit may want to redirect the conversation or to go deeper on a particular subject.

1. Review: What does it mean to be an "exile"?
2. How can you tell if someone you meet is from another country?
3. How can we "tell" people that we follow Jesus—without using words?
4. If Jesus is our Lord and Savior, we belong to God and our true "home" is being with Him. Can remembering this help us resist temptation? How?
5. List 3 creative things your family can do to show God's love to a neighbor during this time when we have to stay inside.
